

John Carroll University Integrative Core Curriculum guide for Cuyahoga Community College courses

The following are courses that will transfer in to JCU and satisfy our integrative core curriculum requirements. However, certain majors may require students to take particular courses to fulfill certain requirements. The list of JCU majors can be seen in the curriculum, which waives the foreign language, distribution, and some of the foundational competencies below, though that which is remaining must be taken at JCU and cannot be transferred in.
